I never have been much of a math guy, but I have always been fascinated with how the numbers play out. One of the ways numbers play out can be found in a mathematical equation called the Pareto Principle. Vilfredo Pareto was an Italian sociologist and economist who calculated that 80% of the land in Italy was owned by 20% of the population. Over the years, the Pareto Principle has been widely used to describe giving and working concepts. For example, 20% of the people give 80% of the funds. 20% of the people do 80% of the work. Why is that? There are many reasons, but one that stands out is in the level of commitment one has to the cause. In our church, those statistics seem to be true, 20% of the people do 80% of the work. Truth be known, we are all called to be and do in the body of Christ. Yet, we often let someone else do the work, lead the ministry, serve someone else, etc. I want to encourage you to change the pattern. Pray and ask God to show you what you need to do. For some reading this, God has called you to a specific ministry within our church. For some, God is calling you to create a new ministry within our church's neighborhood. For some, God is calling you to be involved more in Sunday School, a prayer ministry, or a visitation ministry. CHRCH is not CHURCH without U. You are needed. You are wanted. You are called.
