In All Things

Have you ever wanted just a little bit of what God has for you? Maybe a little love, a little grace, a little forgiveness or a little mercy? Honestly, I would think that would not be the case - you want all of His unlimited resources. You want all the love He has to offer. You want all His grace, mercy and forgiveness.

Recently the phrase "in all things" came to mind. When God says, "in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose," (Romans 8:28) He really means all things - the good, the bad, the ugly. The wayward child, the financial crisis, the emotional mess that is you, the questions about career choices, the health crisis that you never thought you would experience, the craziness that is vour life - all of it God uses for your good.
