Hanging on to His Words

In Luke 19, verses 45-48, it indicates that after Jesus overturned the money tables and drove out the ones there to make a profit from the Temple, He came back each day to teach. The chief priest, the teachers of the law and the leaders among the people were trying to kill Him. It goes on to say that they could not find a way to do it at this point - be sure to see this - "because all the people hung on His words."

That one phrase, "because all the people hung on His words." is truly powerful. It also makes me ask myself a couple of questions. One, am I hanging so closely on to the Word of God, that there is no room for someone to find a way to hurt me? Two, do I spend time in God's Word? Three, do I spend time with Jesus so I can hang on to every word He speaks to me? Four, when He speaks, do I listen and obey or do I ignore what He says to me? Oh, how I want to answer all those questions with a great big YES. Friends, if you are like me, we may have to answer, it depends on the day or the moment. Oh, yes, there is always room for improvement.

Jesus desires us to spend time with Him and to hang on every word that He speaks. I want to be like Jeremiah and say, "His word is in my heart like a fire, a fire shut up in my bones. I am weary of holding it in; indeed, I cannot." Jeremiah 20:9
